

Face-to-face lessons during Covid-19



Please follow these instructions to keep you, your Jacari pupil and their family safe:

Before the face-to-face lesson:

1. Check that you, your pupil and their parents/carers are comfortable to continue face-to-face lessons a few days before. This could change in the coming months.
2. Check no-one in your pupil's household has COVID-19 symptoms via text or WhatsApp.
3. Do a Coronavirus (COVID-19) rapid lateral flow test (available at local pharmacies).

Cancel lesson if you, your pupil or someone in their household has COVID-19 symptoms.

Cancel lesson if you, your pupil or someone in their household tests positive for COVID-19. and/or is contacted by NHS Track and Trace. Only resume after completing recommended isolation period (10 days)

4. Wash/sanitise hands before or on arrival to reduce surface transmission



During the face-to-face lesson

1. Wash/sanitise hands before or on arrival to reduce surface transmission.
2. Wear face masks to reduce air-borne transmission (if you, your pupil and/or their parent/carers are happy to)
3. Ask to open windows and doors to ensure good ventilation.



After the face-to-face lesson

1. Wash/sanitise hands on departure from your pupil's house.

Tell your pupil's parents/carers if you develop COVID-19 symptoms or receive a positive COVID-19 test result.

If you, your pupil or their parents or carers don't feel comfortable continuing with face-to-face lessons at any point, don't hesitate to contact your Jacari Coordinator. We can discuss various options you can take to ensure everyone feels comfortable and safe continuing Jacari tutoring - from asking your pupil's parent/carer to take various precautions, to moving to an online format.

Please follow these instructions to keep everyone safe at Jacari events:



1. Before the event, do a Coronavirus (COVID-19) rapid lateral flow test (available at local pharmacies).
2. Wash/sanitise hands before and after entering the venue to reduce surface transmission.
3. Wear a face mask in inside areas of the venue to reduce potential for airborne transmission.
4. Maintain social distance of at least 1.5 metres from others wherever possible.
