Jacari: Information for Parents / Carers







What is Jacari?

Jacari is a charity in Oxford. We provide **free** teaching to children who don't speak English as a first language and who need extra help with school work.



Who are Jacari teachers?

- Our teachers are volunteers. They do not get paid.
- They are university students or graduates. They are trained but are not fully qualified teachers.
- They have passed a police check to show they can work with children.



The lessons will be on a day and at a time that is good for you, your child and the Jacari teacher. **The lessons will not happen during university holidays.**



What is a Jacari lesson like?

A Jacari lesson could include games, writing practice, reading or help with homework. The lessons will help your child to improve their English and feel more confident in school.



Where will the lessons be?

Jacari lessons will take place in your home, at your child's school or online. You can choose which is easiest for you and best for your child.



What do we need from parents?

- Please be at home when the lessons are happening.
- Please tell your Jacari teacher if you need to cancel the lesson.
- Please tell your Jacari teacher if you have a new phone number or address.
- Don't expect the Jacari teacher to teach all your children. They are only trained to teach one child at a time.



Extra trips and events

Jacari also organises **free** trips and events for the children. Your Jacari teacher will give you a permission slip to fill in for each trip. Parents and brothers/sisters are welcome to come to events too!
